

Residential Geothermal Tax Credit Certificate

TAX YEAR 2022

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, tax incentives for homeowners and businesses are available to help encourage the use of renewable energy technologies like geothermal heat pumps. Tax incentives for ENERGY STAR® qualified residential geothermal heat pumps are available until December 31, 2023.

The law offers a tax credit for all ENERGY STAR qualified residential geothermal heat pump installations until December 31, 2023. To qualify for the rebate, the system must meet or exceed ENERGY STAR requirements and be installed after January 1, 2009. This document can be kept for your records. Consult with your tax advisor for further information.
